PASTOR SEARCH/STUDY COMMITTEE TO BE ELECTED

At the quarterly business meeting which was held on January 17, 2007,
Eliot Hinson, Chairman of Deacons, made the following motion from
the deacon body and it was adopted by the members present. "After
talking with Bro. Austin and meeting with the other deacons, we feel that
it is time to look at forming a Pastor Search/Study Committee. This
Committee will need to study what the Church needs in a pastor, (full
time or part time), and also what the Church can afford by taking into
account the current salaries that are being paid in the field. On Sunday,
February 4th, the Church will accept nominations for individuals to serve
on this Committee. Each member present that day can submit on the
supplied form one (1) to seven (7) names they feel should make up this
Committee. After all are collected and counted, the top seven (7) names
will be asked if they are willing to serve. If any decline, the person with
the next highest count will be asked, etc. until seven (7) are found willing
to serve. As long as Bro. Austin is able to, he will preach (or have some
one fill in when needed) through the end of June or until a new Pastor
is called, whichever comes first."
