Dear Family,

I have began walking my dog, Spencer, in the mornings. This is because throughout the day he is either stuck in a cage or fenced in a yard and really can not get the appropriate exercise needed for a healthy dog. I never realized actually how many dogs there are in my neighborhood until I started walking Spencer. It also has reminded me just how spectacular dogs' senses are, particularly the senses of hearing and smell. The other dogs in the neighborhood will start barking and jumping for Spencer even before they see him and even when we are a couple of houses away.

Our spiritual senses should be the same way. We should fine tune our senses so that we can recognize friend versus foe, peace versus threat, good versus bad, holy versus evil, and Christ versus Satan before it happens upon us. It would be nice to make the proper recognition before these things got too close so we could protect ourselves. It would also be nice to have the ability to tell when they surprise us and come quickly so they could not establish a foothold if did not need to be in our lives.
